### Promote inclusion by art

**From, 16 to 24 July 2019 in PARIS**

#### DESCRIPTION PROJECT

In Europe, inequalities persist among young people with an immigrant background, who are often discriminated against and stereotyped negatively by the media.

The international meeting "Promote inclusion by art" aims to convey a positive and rewarding image of young people from minorities and immigration by highlighting how youth projects can give young people the means to see cultural diversity as an asset and migration as an opportunity.

The main objective of this training is to develop the skills of European organizations and informal groups by facilitating the processes of prevention of discrimination, intercultural dialogue and social cohesion.

General objectives:

- To share perspectives on migration phenomena according to the different European contexts and the different ways of valuing them as opportunities for development within diversity.
- To develop the quality and variety of art-based tools and methodologies in the field of intercultural dialogue, anti-discrimination, migrant inclusion and peacebuilding processes, to encourage organizations to young people and informal groups to create and use them.
- Create a network of organizations that will cooperate in the long term and become a resource for other organizations across Europe.

This project will take place in Yvelines from 16 to 24 July 2019 with the participation of 23 youth workers / youth leaders from 9 organizations from partner countries.



## PROFILE OF PARTICIPANTS

Participants will be over 18 years old and come from partner associations.

Thanks to the application procedure, we will have the choice of the participants. We can therefore compose teams from partner countries, or at least balance all participants to achieve diversity in the team of our project.

The problem of using the artistic tool to create areas of exchange and training is innovative and we want to work on this orientation. From the selection of the partners, they have done the same for their participants. And we want a pluralistic team, which respects the gender aspect and the diversity of cultural approaches as means of social integration. In this project we target youth workers who work with people from migration and / or asylum seekers and refugees.

In order to maximize the possibility for participants to apply and have the largest selection of applications for us, we will broadcast the call via our partner organizations, the web networks of the participating countries and via French partners with an international dimension.

The selection of participants will be made using an application file that will give us information on some key points, including: their interest in the theme of training, their willingness to get involved in the preparation of training , during and after.
